■ Applying for an Exemption from National Pension **Insurance Premiums**

Do you have difficulty paying your National Pension Insurance premiums? Ota City has an exemption scheme that can help.

You must have a personal identification document, Basic Pension Number Notice and other documents to apply. The pension office will assess the income received by you (the applicant), your spouse, and your head of household in the previous year. If your application is then approved, you will be exempted from paying all or part of your National Pension Insurance premiums.

Applications may be made retroactively for premiums owed up to two years and one month in the past.

A new application must be submitted each year. Please visit the Ota City website if you have any questions.

■ Flat-Amount Individual Inhabitant Tax Reduction for FY2024

The flat-amount tax reduction (for individual inhabitant tax) for the 2024 fiscal year will be provided as follows.

Eligibility: Persons liable to pay individual inhabitant tax based on their income whose total income in the previous year amounted to 18.05 million yen or less.

Tax reduction: 10,000 yen for the taxpayer and each dependent (including spouse eligible for tax reduction)


Other matters

Eligible persons must have a domicile in Japan.

No application is required to receive the flat-amount tax reduction.
