


















# About Applying to Use The Family Welfare Worker System from April 2025

The Family Welfare Worker System ("Childcare Mama", "Hoiku Mama" in Japanese) can provide childcare for your child aged up to two years if you are working or have other responsibilities. Ota City will accept applications from individuals wishing to use the system starting on April 1, 2025. Please ask for details.


