Child Allowance Procedures during the Year-End and New Year Holidays

Child allowance applications will not be accepted at service counters (including those of branch offices) between December 29 and January 3. For information on online electronic application, please see the Ota City website or inquire with the office mentioned below. The application deadlines for children who were born or who moved into Ota City in December are as follows.

Date of change*1	Application deadline for "January as first month of payment" 2	
Dec. 1 - 13	Until December 28 Online applications only: Until December 31	
Dec. 14 - 20	Until January 4	
Dec. 21 - 31	Until the 15th day counted from the day following the "date of change" (If the 15th day is a Saturday, Sunday, or national holiday, the deadline will be the next day that government offices are open)	

- *1: Date of childbirth, scheduled moving out date of eligible person who is noted on the "notification of moving out" of the previous address, etc.
- *2: When sending by post, the date that the application must be received by the Medical Care for Children Section

First month of payment

In general, payments will begin from the month following the month of application. However, payments will be made from the month of application if the application was made within 15 days from the day following the "date of change," even if the application was made in the month following the date of change. Attached documents may be submitted at a later date, so it is recommended that you make your application as soon as possible.

Revelations from a Water Basin and Ancient Writings

In front of Kaishu's grave on the shore of Senzokuike pond is a *suiban* water basin. It was dedicated to the late Kaishu by more than 50 donors. This exhibit presents Kaishu's relationships in his later years through materials concerning the people who were associated with the basin's dedication. Planned exhibits include materials relating to the *suiban* basin as well as items that can only be seen in Ota City, among them a Chinese poem composed at Kaishu's Senzokuken villa by Kimura Kaishu, who traveled to the United States with Kaishu aboard the *Kanrin Maru*.
