

# Households How to Separate and **Dispose of Resources and Waste**

Please bring the waste to the collection point by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day. Please do not put out rubbish on days other than collection days or at night.



From April 2025

Separate collection of plastics is commencing throughout the city

- (1) A [Plastics] collection day will be added to the collection days for recyclables and waste.
- (2) The collection day for food trays and Styrofoam will be changed to the "Plastics" collection day.
- (3) Please put out the PET bottle itself on the "Recyclables" collection day.



\*The signage at collection points will be renewed from April 2025, as shown in the image above. Use the information on pages 6 and 7 to enter your recyclables collection/waste collection days in O.

# (1) Plastics

Be sure to dispose only of items made entirely of plastic. Wherever possible, clean plastics before putting them out. Be sure to remove any food scraps, and anything else.

#### Plastic with paper stickers



Peel off anything that can be easily removed.

If you cannot peel off the sticker, just put it out as "plastic" as it is.



# Items that cannot be collected as plastic (Example)

Anything that is partially or wholly made of materials other than plastic



Items with many metal parts, battery-powered items Noncombustible waste

Items other than the above (including items with a small amount of metal attached)

# (2) Recyclables 7 items

As the waste disposal facility and method vary depending on the category, the collection time and vehicle vary.

Separate into each category and tie them together with a piece of string. Do not use any adhesive tape.

## (1) Newspapers and flyers

Inserted flvers are also collected together



# (3) Cartons

Rinse it and cut it open



#### (2) Magazines and scrap paper

Books, leaflets, wrapping paper, cartons, egg carton boxes, etc. are also accepted



#### (4) Cardboard boxes

Get rid of slip sheets, adhesive tape, and clasps



## Please separate each item and place them in bags that make the contents visible.

### (5) Food and beverage bottles

Lids are collected depending on the material

# (6) Food and beverage cans

Also collecting confectionery and seaweed cans, including the lid, as recyclables

\*Please rinse items (5), (6) and (7) with water before disposal.

#### Dirty plastic

Do not put out plastics that cannot be rinsed with water to remove grime on the plastics collection day



## Rubber products



#### Small amount of stems and leaves

(Cut them into 50 cm long or so and tie them together with a piece of string)



\*Trunks must be less than 10 cm thick

#### Non-recyclable paper





# Diaper

(Remove excrement and seal the bag up)



### Waste cooking oil

(Soak it into paper or cloth, or solidify it with a coagulant agent)




#### **Requests / Cautions**

- · Drain water from kitchen waste before disposing. Additionally, wrapping kitchen waste in newspapers or fliers can help to deter crows.
- · Please wrap any sharp items such as bamboo skewer with paper etc.

#### Requests / Cautions

· Sharp items such as glass, needles or blades should be disposed of in sturdy containers, wrapped in paper, or otherwise safely disposed of, with the word "danger" ("危険") clearly displayed on the outside.

# Small rechargeable batteries

(Lithium-ion batteries, nickel-metal hydride batteries, nickel-cadmium batteries, etc.)

◆ The collection is carried out by retail shops and JBRC collection agencies.

\*For rechargeable batteries that cannot be picked up at the above stores, please contact the Waste Reduction Promotion Division or the Waste Collection Office.

# **Noncombustible** waste is collected "twice a month".

Collection will be on the days that fall under the "1st and 3rd" or "2nd and 4th" times of the month.

\*The 29th to 31st will be on the "5th" time, so noncombustible waste will not be collected.

Hours: 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (except Dec. 29 to Jan. 3 and maintenance inspection days several times a year)



- Furniture, bedding, electrical appliances, and other items from households that measure approximately 30 cm or more on a side are eligible.
- Air conditioner, Television, Fridge (and freezer), Washing machine, Clothes dryer, and computer are not eligible.
- Please apply by phone (Japanese, English, Chinese, Korean, Portuguese, Spanish, Thai, Vietnamese) or online (Japanese, English, Chinese, Korean).
- Collection dates and fees will be provided upon application.
- Purchase an Ota City Paid Bulky Waste Disposal Ticket at a supermarket or convenience store.
- Write your collection date, name, or receipt number on the paid bulky waste disposal ticket.
- Please put it out by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day at the place you decided when you made the reservation.
- There is also a system where you can bring your bulky waste in yourself (only by telephone application).

Please affix a paid bulky waste disposal ticket.

### When putting out a large amount of waste at once (extra waste)

- The amount of waste that you can bring to a waste collection point at a time is up to 3 bags for 45 liters. (up to 3 bundles of branches)
- · Fee payable for 4 or more bags.
- Inquires to the Waste Collection Office.


# Animal carcasses (pets)

Carcasses of dogs, cats, etc. raised at home can be accepted for a fee only if they weigh less than 25 kg (3,100 yen per animal)

· Register at the Waste Collection Office.

# Bird proof nets are available to hire

We provide bird proof nets to prevent damage caused by crows and other birds. Please ask your area's Waste Collection Office for details.



# Hazardous items, flammable items, dangerous items, foul-smelling items

Petroleum (gasoline, diesel, kerosene, thinner, engine oil, paint etc.), Gas cartridges (propane gas, oxygen etc.), General waste subject to special control (PCB parts, infectious waste etc.), Fireworks, Matches, Batteries. Poisonous or deleterious substance, and other hazardous items

# Other items that the city cannot collect

Soil, sand, stones, ashes, concrete blocks, bricks, pianos, fireproof safes, tires, motorcycles, automobiles, other liquid items, etc. \*To dispose of fire extinguishers, contact the Fire Extinguisher Recycling Promotion Center (TEL: 03-5829-6773).

#### Businesses are required by law to treat waste that they dispose of on their own responsibility.

### As a general rule, businesses should outsource waste disposal to a private waste collector.

There are two methods; asking a licensed company to collect and transport the waste, or bringing the waste directly to a treatment facility.

For more information, please contact the Waste Collection Office or the Waste Reduction Promotion Division (03-5744-1629).

- When contracting a private waste collector, confirm what is to be collected, the approximate volume, who will transport it, and where, how and who will dispose of it at the destination.
- The city's service is for waste and recyclables from households. As long as there is no interference with domestic waste collection, the city collects business waste and recyclables for a fee.
- When asking the city to collect business waste and recyclables, please affix a pay business waste treatment ticket issued by Ota City to the waste or recyclables before putting out. You must fill in your shop or company name on the ticket. Categories are the same as for domestic waste.
- There are some waste that the city cannot collect. (the waste in a powdery state or with oil etc.)
- O Business bulky waste cannot be collected by the city.
- If you wish to dispose of business waste and recyclables for collection by the city, see here →



■ You can purchase a pay business waste treatment ticket at shops, supermarkets, convenience stores, and the Waste Collection Office with an "Ota city waste ticket is available here" sign.

#### Tickets issued by other cities are not accepted.

- As a rule, pay business waste treatment tickets cannot be refunded, unless certain requirements are met. For further information, please contact the respective Waste Collection Office or the Waste Reduction Promotion Division (03-5744-1374).
- Revised fees for business recyclables and waste have been in place since October 2023.
  The procedures for refunds of business waste treatment tickets (tickets with "Revised October 2017" written on the name) that were discontinued at the end of September 2023 and exchange for current tickets by paying the difference will end on October 31, 2028. Please note that the procedure is not available after November 1, 2028.
